## TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Ts & Cs)

1. Entry is open to all primary and high school and home schooled students in the greater Bunbury area: North to Yarloop, East to Collie and South to Capel.
2. The competition is open to students in three categories: **Cat.1.**Pre-primary to Year 2, **Cat.2.**Year 3 to Year 6 and **Cat.3.**Year 7 to Year 12.
3. Posters have been created by the entrant.
4. Entries limited to ONE poster per student.
5. The entry is not in breach of any intellectual property rights and that entrants have secured all the necessary intellectual property rights in relation to their entry. Zonta Club of Bunbury (the Promoter) accepts no responsibility in the event that the entrant has not done so.
6. **The poster theme is RESPECT and 1800RESPECT must be included somewhere on the poster.**
7. Words may be used to highlight the ideas in the poster. No swear words or profanities.
8. Entries must be submitted as an A4 or A3 size poster, using any art material, including: paint, collage, pencil or computer graphics.
9. Posters must be able to **fit into an A4 or an A3 frame** to be displayed.
10. Entries submitted by email must be an electronic high-resolution file or scan of the original artwork in PDF, png, or jpeg format. The file size must not exceed 10MB.
11. The entry form must include a **brief written description (no more than 10 words)** of what the poster is about. Teachers or parents may act as scribes for Students in Category 1 if they dictate their poster's description.
12. Posters will be judged on: creativity, relevance to theme, content and layout/design.
13. Entries must be received by **5:00pm on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2022** by:

  - **posting to:** Zonta Poster Competition, PO Box 1395, Bunbury WA 6231 (Last post-marked date for posted entries to be accepted is 21<sup>st</sup> October 2022). No extension to this date will be granted.
14. If posting or delivering entry, the Completed Entry Form – (page 1) to be attached to the BACK of the poster using glue or sticky tape (Do not use staples, pins or paperclips).
15. All entries will be evaluated in good faith by a judging panel selected by Zonta Bunbury. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into about the evaluation or the decision of the judging panel or the processes in connection with the evaluation or decision.
16. Submitted artwork will not be returned to the entrant unless otherwise requested and arranged with the Zonta Club of Bunbury by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022.
17. Competition finalists will be asked to allow their poster be used for promotional purposes during the 16 Days of Activism campaign (25<sup>th</sup> November – 10<sup>th</sup> December 2022), with only their first name, year level, school name used. All other personal information will remain confidential.
18. Artists will be credited as above whenever the posters are used.
19. Entries from students must have legal guardian consent.
20. Signing the entry form for this competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
21. Winners will be announced at a function on **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 5-7pm** at the Stirling Street Arts Centre, Bunbury. The selected finalists and schools will be contacted ahead of time.
22. Prizes will consist of:
  - First place in each category - \$150
  - Second place - \$50.00
  - Certificate of commendation to each finalist
23. Schools of participating students will receive a letter of commendation.
